

Resolution of 13<sup>th</sup> July 2016, which allocates scholarships for student mobility from partner countries under the Erasmus + KA107-2015 Programme

Once the selection process established in the call for applications Erasmus+ KA107-2015 for scholarships for student mobility from partner countries (Mobilities during the 2016-2017 academic year, always before 31st July 2017)

## I HEREBY RESOLVE:

<u>First</u>. To provisionally award scholarships from funds of the European Commission to the students from partner countries listed in the annex attached to this resolution in accordance with the criteria set out in the call for applications approved by the Comissió d'Afers Acadèmics of 22 January 2016.

<u>Second</u>. The final award of these scholarships will not occur until the student is effectively registered at the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona and has completed all the procedures required in accordance with the conditions of the call.

<u>Third</u>. In order to award the still available scholarships, and taking into account that the project duration has been extended until 31<sup>th</sup> July 2017, a fourth round will be open from 15<sup>th</sup> July 2016 ongoing for student mobility during the academic year 2016/17. Resolutions will be launched every month in case applications are submitted and scholarships are still available. Applications still in process will be resolved in the next resolution.
