

Resolution of 5 February 2016, which allocates scholarships for student mobility from partner countries under the Erasmus + KA107-2015 Programme

Once the selection process established in the **call for applications Erasmus+ KA107-2015 for scholarships for student mobility from partner countries** (Mobilities during the second semester of the 2015-2016 academic year or the first semester of the 2016-2017 academic year, always before 30 May 2017)

## I HEREBY RESOLVE:

<u>First</u>. Provisionally award scholarships from funds of the European Commission to the students from partner countries listed in the annex attached to this decision in accordance with the criteria set out in the call for applications approved by the Comissió d'Afers Acadèmics of 22 January 2016.

<u>Second</u>. The final award of these scolarships will not occur until the student is effectively registered at Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona and has completed all the procedures required in accordance with the conditions of the call.
