ENGLISH PRONUNCIATION FOR TEACHERS

Course for improving aspects of pronunciation and prosody in English. Special attention is given to knowledge of sounds and their correct pronunciation, the relationship between letters and sounds, the melodic curve and intonation of sentences in English, stress patterns, rhythm and speed of elocution, the differences between the large variants of the language. Classes begin with an initial diagnosis individually and in groups and attention is given to specific needs such as the pronunciation of specialised academic terms.

Aimed at

Lecturers with a medium to high level of accuracy and fluency in English who want to improve aspects of pronunciation and prosody.

Level required

Level 5 of the Language Service passed (B2.2 of the CEFR) or equivalent.
