He/She supports the well being and coping of the patient and his or her family.						
He/She identifies and prevents situations that threaten the mental health of the patient/client and helps him or her by means of nursing care if necessary.						
He/She assesses and relieves patient's/client's pain and suffering in different situations including terminal care.						
He/She gives first aid in different nursing settings and provides basic resuscitation according to authorisation with or without aids as well as advanced life support.						
He/She follows the valid instructions in emergencies and crisis situations.						
He/She knows how to use medical equipment safely and ergonomically.						
He/She is capable of assessing the need for holistic nursing care.						
He/She administers medication safely as prescribed by a physician and monitors the effects and effectiveness of the medication.						
He/She masters clinical calculations and central clinical pharmacology and knows how to apply it in nursing care of different age groups.						
He/She masters fluid balance care and preparation measures for intravenous infusions and blood transfusions, is able to prepare the patient for the treatments and to monitor the patient during and after the procedures.						
He/She knows how to do peripheral intravenous cannulation and carry out intravenous fluid care.						
He/She is able to carry out infusions and medical therapy into a central vein.						
He/She is capable of identifying the risks involved in medical therapy and uses the collected data of medical therapy to develop the medication processes.
