RESEARCH PAPERS (HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES)

Course covering the most usual genres of discourse in scientific communication, scientific articles or papers. Participants develop and consolidate the necessary skills for writing scientific articles in English. Students work on producing accurate and appropriate vocabulary, grammar and syntax structures. The aim of the course is not to write a paper but to learn how to do so.

Aimed at

These courses are principally intended for UAB lecturing staff, who receive a 100% subsidy for this. The week before the start of the course, if places are still available, lecturing and research staff from affiliated schools or other universities, as well as MA, PhD and postgraduate students, may also enrol.

Level required

Level 5 of the Language Service passed (B2.2 of the CEFR) or equivalent.

Calendar and timetable
