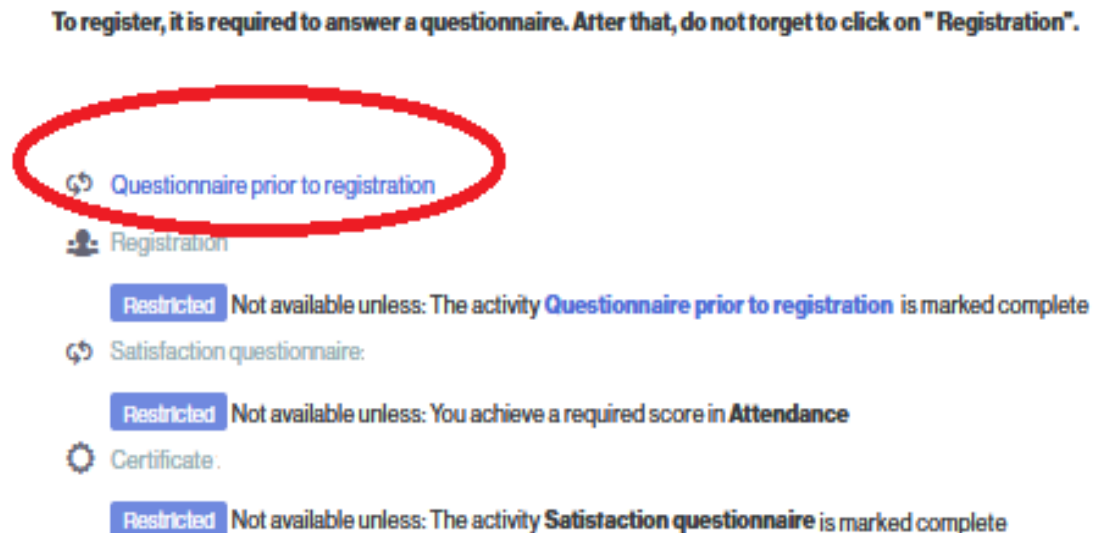
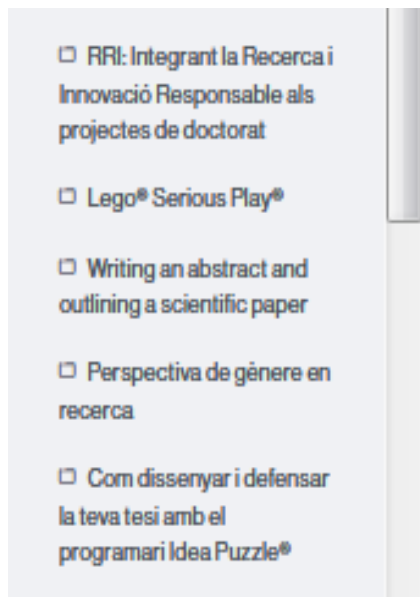


How to download your certificate
