## **THESIS WRITING IN ENGLISH (HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES)**

A support course for thesis writing in English. The course covers issues relating to academic/scientific writing, focussing on the features of specialised language within the conventions of formal university texts. This course has been created to provide support in the process of thesis writing. Participants are encouraged to bring fragments of their own thesis in order to help them resolve specific difficulties with their writing.\*

### **Aimed at**

Doctoral students, for whom the course is 100% subsidised.

### **Level required**

Successful completion of Level 5 (B2.2 of the CEFR, or equivalent).
