THESIS WRITING IN ENGLISH (SCIENCES, HEALTH SCIENCES & ENGINEERING)

A support course for thesis writing in English. The course covers issues relating to academic/scientific writing, focussing on the features of specialised language within the conventions of formal university texts. This course has been created to provide support in the process of thesis writing. Participants are encouraged to bring fragments of their own thesis in order to help them resolve specific difficulties with their writing.*

Aimed at

Doctoral students, for whom the course is 100% subsidised.

Level required

Successful completion of Level 5 (B2.2 of the CEFR, or equivalent).

Calendar and timetables

First edition: from 23.10.2023 to 27.11.2023, Mondays and Wednesdays, 5pm to 7pm.

Second edition: from 19.2.2024 to 20.3.2024 Mondays and Wednesdays, 5pm to 7pm (this course will be taught live online, by videoconference).

Duration

20 classroom hours + 10 hours' self-study.
